

**Washington D.C.** – Congressman Kevin McCarthy released the following statement regarding the passage of H.R. 1, Full Year Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011:

*"Today the House took a meaningful first step in removing barriers to job growth by reining in the culture of spending in Washington.
