

Washington D.C. – Congressman Kevin McCarthy issued the following statement regarding the White House announcement of its Regulatory Review Plans:

"At the beginning of the year, President Obama said he was committed to unwinding the regulatory red tape that is strangling job creation in our country, yet communities across the country continue to suffer from record levels of unemployment.
